

## April 26, Family Discussion Questions



**Directions:** Thank you for listening to this week's sermon in Deuteronomy. Hopefully, you are gathered with family or friends now to read the Bible together and share with one another what you've learned and been challenged with. This can also be done on your own as a reflection.

**Open your Bibles** to Deuteronomy 4:1, 9-16. Have someone read aloud, or take turns reading portions of the passage. Discuss some of the questions below together.

1. What is one thing that you learned **new** in the passage? Did something stick out to you in a new way?
2. How would you describe your best life? When you're at the end of life (like Moses) what would you be most proud of in your life?
3. Look at 4:1. What instruction does Moses give the people? Why is this so important?
4. In 4:10, Moses reminds the people to fear the Lord all their days on the earth, and to teach their children to do so. What does it mean to fear the Lord?
5. How does fearing God influence your decisions and goals?
6. What did you learn about God in Deuteronomy 4? Can you find the verses in Deuteronomy 4 to support that attribute of God?
7. In 4:16, Moses warned the people not to make carved images to worship. By doing so, the people reduce God to something less than He really is. How do we do this in our own lives today?
8. Read Hebrews 8:6. How does Jesus mediate a better covenant for us today?
9. What is one thing this passage leads you to do in obedience?
10. What does this passage prompt you to pray for specifically?

**Take time and pray together.** Submit your goals, aspirations, decisions, and thoughts to God. Seek to know and understand God more and more and be willing to let Him reign over your whole life. Pause and marvel over God's power, authority, and beauty. Express thanks to God for loving you and showing mercy.
