April 5, Family Discussion Questions



Directions: We started a new Easter series this morning! Over the next few weeks, we journey with Jesus through Jerusalem to the cross, resurrection and ascension. I encourage you to open your Bibles together and walk through these questions. Share your answers with one another and encourage one another in the Word. Let God impress His Word on your hearts as a family. This can be done together, or individually. Remember your goal isn't to get through all the questions, but to get God's Word through you.

Open your Bibles to Luke 19:28-48 Have someone read aloud, or take turns reading portions of the passage. These verses include 3 passages: The Triumphal Entry, Jesus' Weeps over Jerusalem, and Cleansing the Temple. Then discuss some of the questions below together.

- 1. What is one thing that you learned *new* in the passage? Did something stick out to you in a new way?
- 2. In these passages, we witness several actions and responses of Jesus to things. What do you learn about Jesus from these passages? What is important to Him? How does He respond to things?
- 3. In what ways do we follow His example today?
- 4. In Luke 19:28-40, Jesus enters Jerusalem, welcomed as a King by His disciples. How did the disciples worship Jesus? How did they give witness about Jesus?
- 5. In Luke 19:41-44, why did Jesus weep over the people of Jerusalem? How does this reflect the character of Jesus? In what ways, can we build the same character in our hearts?
- 6. In Luke 19:47, the chief priests, scribes and principal men of the people were seeking to destroy Jesus. They have been looking for the Messiah all their life, and yet have totally missed the truth of Jesus in front of them. Why was it hard for them to accept Jesus?
- 7. What is one thing this passage leads you to do in obedience?
- 8. What does this passage prompt you to pray for specifically?

Take time and pray together. Reflect in prayer on your worship and witness of King Jesus today. Pray for compassion for the lost and community around us. Humble yourself before the Lord and enter worship with the right heart attitude.
