

## May 3, Family Discussion Questions



**Directions:** Thank you for listening to this week's sermon. As you discuss together, focus on your relationship with God and with others. What is your motivation for obeying Jesus?

**Open your Bibles** to Deuteronomy 4:37-40, 5:1. Have someone read aloud, or take turns reading portions of the passage. Discuss some of the questions below together.

1. What is one thing that you learned *new* in the passage? Did something stick out to you in a new way?
2. What do you learn about God in Deuteronomy 4:37-40? What is He like? How did He treat the Israelites?
3. How did God demonstrate His love for the Israelites?
4. In Deuteronomy 5:1, what was expected of the Israelites?
5. God gave the Israelites the 10 Commandments to follow. Without looking can you and your family name all ten?
6. The first 4 commands focus on our relationship with God. The other 6 focus on our relationship with people. How does seeking God first in our lives influence our relationship with others?
7. Read Matthew 22:37-40. How did Jesus summarize the law? Read John 14:15.
8. Read Galatians 3:24, 6:2. As Christians how do we relate to the Old Testament law today?
9. What is one thing this passage leads you to do in obedience?
10. What does this passage prompt you to pray for specifically?

**Take time and pray together.** Examine your motives for obedience to God. Ask him to change your heart and help you to follow Him in response to His great love for you. Repent of an attitude of duty or performance. Ask the Lord to strengthen you and to continue teaching you from His word that you will live to glorify Him in everything.
