1. What is one thing that you learned **new** in the passage? Did something stick out to you in a new way?
2. Moses repeated some familiar phrases from the last few chapters in verses 1-3. What did he remind the people of?
3. Look at verse 4. This verse was the Jews as the Lord's prayer is to the Christian. Everybody is familiar with it. Why do you think this verse is so important?
4. Jesus quoted Deuteronomy 6:5 and called it the Great Commandment. How would you explain this verse in your own words? What is it like to love God like this?
5. In verse 7-9, Moses gives 4 instructions:  
Teach these commands  
Talk of these commands  
Bind these commands as signs  
Write these commands

What are some ways your family follows these instructions in your home? Or with grandkids?

6. What do you learn about God in this passage?
7. What is one thing this passage demands of you?
8. What does this passage prompt you to pray for specifically?

**Take time and pray together.** Thank the Lord for parents and grandparents that helped you know the ways of the Lord. Ask the Lord to help you love Him completely, and to remember the good things He has done for you. Yield your life to the Lord as an act of love for God who gave Himself up for you.
