

May 10, Family Discussion Questions



Directions: This sermon may have seemed like it was for our moms, but there is something each one of us can gain. As we explore this passage together, let your thoughts focus on how you are honoring and praising the moms in your life.

Open your Bibles to Proverbs 31:10-31. Have someone read aloud, or take turns reading portions of the passage. Discuss some of the questions below together.

1. Share a memory about your mom that is especially fond for you. Take turns sharing with one another.
2. What is one thing that you learned *new* in the passage? Did something stick out to you in a new way?
3. Mom, after reading this passage, how do you feel? Do you feel accomplished? Do you feel overwhelmed? Do you feel insecure? Do you feel joy?
4. Husbands and kids go back through the passage and find a verse that you think describes your mom. Tell her why you think so.
5. The sermon emphasized the value of moms, the selfless attitude of moms, and mom's fear of the Lord. What evidence from the passage do you find to support these?
6. Proverbs 31:28 talks of how the family praises mom. What are some ways you can show mom appreciation and love?
7. What do you learn about God in this passage?
8. What does this passage prompt you to pray for specifically?

Take time and pray together. Pray for the moms in your life. Thank God for them and all that they do for you and others. Ask the Lord to strengthen and encourage them in their work. Ask the Lord to help you honor and love the moms in your life well.
