Sermon Notes:

God has made a way for people to enter the kingdom of heaven, but not everyone will.

Everyone will be somewhere after death – heaven or hell.

Hell is a real place of eternal punishment.

Hell is a place of pain (Lk. 16:24), permanent hopelessness (Lk. 16:26), separation (Lk. 16:26), and fear (Lk. 16:27).

Each one of us has the opportunity to respond with repentance and faith in our lifetime.
